

OMEA Administrator of the Year

This fall the OMEA Awards and Recognition Committee will meet to choose school administrators in the State of Oklahoma who show exceptional support for their school's music program. This award provides our organization the opportunity to honor those who have supported music as an important part of the total curriculum, and have given administrative support to music teachers and directors. Nominees may be active or retired. They may be in any level of administration, such as superintendent, principal, department head, coordinator, supervisor, etc.

Eligibility

1. This administrator demonstrates support of music as an important part of the total curriculum.
2. This administrator attends public performances of school ensembles.
3. This administrator supports the school or district music faculty.

Nomination

This nomination form must include the signature of the music teacher submitting the nomination. The music teacher submitting this application must have worked with the nominee for a period of at least four school terms, and must be a current member of OMEA. Send this form and a photograph of the nominee (the most recent possible) to the OMEA Higher Ed VP no later than September 15, 2008. The Awards and Recognition committee will then meet to choose the candidates, using information from these nominations forms. Their choices will be presented to the October meeting of the Executive Board for final approval. Only nominees processed through the Awards and Recognition Committee are eligible.
